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**ORDERS**

In G.O. first read above orders were issued among others permitting the Member Secretary, Gurukulam to establish four English Medium Residential Schools for STs under the management of Gurukulam at Hyderabad, Warangal, Thirupathi and Vishakapatham.

The Member Secretary, Gurukulam in his letter second read above, has informed that staff was not sanctioned and also reported that there is no surplus posts in Trained Graduate Teacher and PGT cadre as these cadre were converted into Junior Lecturer posts and were filled by promotion during the year 2002 – 2003. He has requested the Government to sanction staff for the said four English Medium Residential Schools

Government after careful examination the proposal here by sanction the following teaching and non-teaching staff duly prescribing method of appointment against the posts for the four English Medium Residential Schools at Hyderabad, Warangal, Thirupathi and Vishakapatham.

### **DRAFT MEMORANDUM FOR THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS**

Sub:- Tribal Welfare – Gurukulam Establishment of 4 English Medium Residential Schools for ST's at Hyderabad, Warangal, Thirupathi and Visakapatham under the management of Gurukulam - Sanction of staff -orders issued – Ratification – Regarding.

The proposal relates to sanction of staff for four (4) English Medium Residential Schools at Hyderabad, Warangal, Visakhapatnam and Thirupathi

In G.O.Ms.No. 106, Social Welfare (Tribal Welfare – Edn.II) Department, dated 21-09-2002 orders were issued for sanctioning 4 English Medium Residential School at Hyderabad, Warangal, Viskhapatnam and Thirupathi, among others an amount of Rs 260 lakhs towards non recurring expenditure for buildings and an amount of Rs. 22.52 lakhs towards recurring expenditure for the first year subject to meet the expenditure form the funds available with Commissioner of Triabl Welfare under Best Available schools at Hyderabad Public School Scheme (pre-metric scholarships ) and there shall not be any additional financial commitment over and above the Budget accordingly the schools at Hyderabad was started during the year 2002 – 2003 and the rest of the three schools were, proposed to start during the year 2003 – 2004.

The Member Secretary, Gurukulam stated that Govt. while sanctioning the 4 English Medium Schools, have not sanctioned the staff required for running the schools and directed Gurukulam to adjust with the existing staff due to conversion of Trained Graduate Teacher and Post Graduate Teacher cadre into Junior Lecturers by promotion during the year 2002 –2003. Therefore, the Member Secretary, Gurukulam reported that there is no option for them and request the Government for sanction of 17 Teaching and 12 non-teaching staff to each school and also sanction an amount of Rs. 98.2 lakhs (for both teaching and non teaching staff)

In this connection, it is submitted that there is a budget of about 10 crores under pre-metric sholarship under the bright boys scheme. In one of the reviews by the Hon,ble C.M. it has been decided to start (4) English medium residential schools at Hyderabad, Warangal, Vishakapatnam and Thirupathi in place of sending Tribal Students to **H P S** where their performance has not been started in Narsapur, Medak District, In 2002 – 2003 and remaining (3) schools are to be started in the year 2003–04. The recurring expenditure for (4) residential schools would be met from the

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budget available under pre-matric scholarship scheme and non-recurring expenditure like construction of school buildings would be taken up with the funds available in the State plan / Govt. of

India assistance.

The Finance (Exp-SW) Dept., have agreed to sanction the following Staff for 4 English Medium Residential Schools and advised the Department to obtain orders in circulation including Hon'ble Chief Minister and also placing the matter before cabinet.

The matter is now placed before the Council of Ministers for ratification of the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No. 53, Social Welfare (Tribal Welfare-Edn.I) Deparatment, dated 09-09-2003.

In this connection, it is submitted there is a budget of about 10 crores under pre-metric scholarship under the Bright Boys Scheme is available, hence the Hon'ble Chief Minister it has been decided to start (4) English Medium Residential Schools at Hyderabad, Warangal, Vishakapatnam and Thirupathi in place of sending Tribal Students to H.P.S where their performance has not been up to the mark. Accordingly the school at Hyderabad has been started in Narsapur, Medak District. In 2002 – 2003 and remaining (3) schools are to be started in the year 2003 – 04. The recurring expenditure for (4) residential schools would be met from the budget available under pre-matric school buildings would be taken up with the funds available in the State plan / Govt. of India assistance.
