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ORDER : -

In the G.O.first read above, orders have been issued recognizing certain private hospitals within and outside the State as referral hospitals for the treatment of the Government employees, Retired employees and their dependents on reimbursement basis. Subsequently, some more hospitals have also been included in the list of recognized hospitals as referral hospitals within the State.

2. In the reference third read above, the Managing Director of Sri Sai Kidney Centre (A unit of twin cities Kidney Centre Private Limited), Near Lal Bungalow, Ameerpet, Hyderabad has stated that their Kidney Centre is provided with all the Super Specialty wings of Genito Urinary Surgery and offer the best services to the patients. The Managing Director has also stated that their kidney center provided with subject specialists who are thoroughly involved in drug therapeutics, its integrations, side effects and compliance, all conforming to good clinical, community and hospital pharmacy practices. He has furnished the list of consultants, facilities available and tariff. The Managing Director of Sri Sai Kidney Centre, Hyderabad has requested the Government to provide an opportunity to safeguard the health of the employees and precious human assets with a promise to do their best to improve the quality of life and help the workforce to lead health productive life all these at very reasonable cost and requested to enroll their "Sri Sai Kidney Centre, Ameerpet, Hyderabad in the approved list of treatment centers.

3. The matter has been referred to the Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad for report. The Director of Medical Education, has in turn referred to the Superintendent , Gandhi Hospital, Secunderabad for report. The inspection committee of Gandhi Hospital has visited Sri Sai Kidney Centre, Hyderabad - 500 016 on 29th August, 2001. The Inspection Committee has reported that pharmacy is present with all emergency drugs. Male and Female patient wards with general ward facility as well as independent and sharing rooms are available. Laboratory facilities for all investigations pertaining to Urological diseases along with 300 MA X - Ray Plant are present.

4. Inspection Committee has stated that Operation Theatres are having the equipment like Three Channel monitor and defibrillator and pulse oximeters. All items for successful conduction of anaesthesia available. Two vertical Autoclaves for continuous sterilization present. As regards the Surgical equipment,

the equipments available are ESWL, (Dornier), endourology equipment to conduct PCNL, URSL, RURP, operations apart from laparoscopic urology equipment. C Arm facilities are available. The Inspection committee has also stated that High Resolution Ultra Sound equipment and equipment for urodynamic studies available. Intensive care unit adjacent to operation theatre complex with monitors, oxygen source and ventilator siemens 900 existing. Two dialysis machines available for heemodialysis with water treatment plant with separate ward facility is present.

5. Inspection Committee has recommended that all the facilities in the hospital are available and the said hospital can be recognized as a referral hospital for treatment of State Government employees both in service, retired and their dependents for reimbursement purpose.

6. In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Medical Education has forwarded the above Inspection Report and requested the Government to initiate the action in the matter.

7. In the letter fifth read above, the Managing Director, Sri Sai Kidney Centre, Ameerpet, Hyderabad has been informed that Government proposed the following conditions for according recognition of their hospital.

- (a) The recognized hospital should charge 10% less than NIMS rates
- (b) To give 10% free treatment including in-patient treatment for white card holders
- (c) To adopt two Primary Health Centres in rural areas for delivery of quality and better health services to rural people

8. In the representation sixth read above, the Managing Director, Sri Sai Kidney Centre, Ameerpet, Hyderabad has accepted to give 10% free treatment to white card holders, to charge 10% less than NIMS rates and to adopt two Primary Health Centres in Rural areas to give better health services.

9. Government after careful consideration of the matter and in terms of rule 7 of Andhra Pradesh Integrated Medical Attendance Rules, 1972, hereby accord recognition to Sri Sai Kidney Centre (A unit of twin cities Kidney Centre Private Limited), Near Lal Bungalow, Ameerpet, Hyderabad - 500 016 as a referral hospital for the specialized treatments to the State Government employees, their dependents and retired State Government Employees and their dependents on reimbursement basis and also for those specialized treatments which are not available in Government Teaching Hospitals / NIMS/ SVIMS, subject to the following conditions.

- (i) The above mentioned private hospital will be referral hospital for emergency cases of Acute Renal Failure; and urology Dept cases;
- (ii) Referral of patients to the above private hospital should be from the Director, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad, Director, Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupathi and other Government Teaching Hospitals in the State;
- (iii) The NIMS/SVIMS, Government Teaching Hospitals shall ensure that facilities available in their hospitals are fully utilized in the first instance, before referring the patients to the above private hospital.
- (iv) The aforesaid hospital should charge 10% less than the NIMS rates from the State Government employees and their dependents, retired State Government employees and their dependents. The hospital while issuing bills, a certificate should be issued to concerned employee / retired employee to the effect that the charges collected are 10% less than the existing NIMS rates for the said treatment.
- (v) The aforesaid hospital should give free medical treatment for Clinical Services, Diagnostic Services and also Inpatient Services for white card holders of the State of Andhra Pradesh to a minimum of 5% (Five percent) of the patients treated in the hospital in a financial year. They should not collect any fees / charges from the white card holders for the treatment and services rendered to them. This should be properly documented in a Register by the said hospital and the

said register is subject to periodic verification by the officer of O/o Director, Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad. The cases referred by District Collectors / District Referral Committees shall be admitted for free treatment accordingly.

(vi) The hospital should adopt any 2 slums for free screening and IEC or any two Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in rural areas for delivery of better health services to rural people. The Director of Medical Education will identify the two Primary Health Centres for this purpose in consultation with the hospital, and intimate the same to all concerned including District Medical & Health Officer concerned, Director of Health, AP, Hyderabad and Government.

(vii) A 20% cut shall be imposed on the gross admissible amount within the ceiling limit as certified by the Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad on the cases where the patient admitted in the above private hospital under emergency condition without referral letter from NIMS/SVIMS/ any Government Teaching Hospital.

10. The permission accorded in para (9) above is liable for cancellation and such other action as deemed fit, whenever the State Government forms the opinion that the said Private Hospital is not providing treatment to the State Government employees / retired employees and their dependents as stipulated above and violates the above conditions mentioned therein, after giving (15) days notice to the hospital and pass appropriate orders, after considering the representation, is any, offered by the said hospital.

11. The Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad shall take necessary further action in the matter accordingly.

12. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department, vide their U.O.No. 1729/51/A2/EBS-VIII/2003, dated 5/2/2003.
