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**ORDER:**

In the G.O. first read above, orders have been issued recognising certain private hospitals within and outside the State as referral hospitals for the treatment of the Government employees, Retired employees and their dependents on reimbursement basis. Subsequently, some more hospitals have also been recognised and included in the list of recognised hospitals as referral hospitals within the State.

2. In the representation third read above, the General Manager of Yashoda Super Speciality Hospital, Somajiguda, Hyderabad as stated that their hospital is one of the leading Hospitals in Hyderabad providing a complete Health Care Services and that it is ideally located, and is about 2 kms from the Airport and provides general and specialised services in the following fields:

1. Cardiology and Cardiothoracic Surgeries
2. Renal Transplantations.
3. Neurology and Neuro-Surgery.
4. Orthopedics and Traumatology.
5. Endocrinology
6. Gastroenterology
7. Plastic Surgery.

3. The General Manager of the Yashoda hospital, Somajiguda has also stated that Cardiology and Cardio - Thoracic Surgeries are fully equipped to perform latest procedures like Mitral Ballonvalvuloplasty, Pulmonary Baloon Valvuloplasty, P.T.C.A's Coronary tests, By-pass Surgeries, Open Hearty Surgeries, Valve Replacements etc. and Nephrology and Urology - One of the most comprehensive departments of its kind with Endo-urology and Uro-oncology, Sub-specialities, PCNL and ureterorenoscopy facilities. Dialysis facility and Neurology and Neuro-surgeries. A wide spectrum of equipments like latest generation MRI, whole body CT Scanner, EEG, EMG, Neuro Sonograph Carotid Doppler studies modern theatre complex equipped to handle head and spinal injuries, Micro Neuro Surgery of Vascular lesions, brain and spinal tumors etc. Orthopaedics and Trumatology - Multispeciality Management of all types of Poly - Trauma, Hip/knee replacements Surgeries, shoulder joint replacements etc. Gynaecology /Obstertric, Paediatrics & Neonatology, Dermatology and Ophtholmology

4. The General Manager of the Hospital has therefore requested the Government to recognise Yashoda Super Speciality Hospital, Somajiguda, Hyderabad as a referral hospital for treatment of State Government employees / Retired employees and their dependents.

5. In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Medical Education, Hyderabad has forwarded the inspection report submitted by the Superintendent, Osmania General Hospital, Hyderabad in respect of the above Hospital. The Director of Medical Education has recommended that Yashoda Super Speciality Hospital, Somajiguda Hyderabad may be recognised as referral Hospital for the treatment of the State Government employees both in service and retired and their dependents for reimbursement purpose.

6. In the letter fifth read above, the General Manager of Yashoda Hospital Somajiguda, Hyderabad has been informed that Government proposed the following conditions for according recognition of their Hospital:-

- a) The recognised hospital should charge 10% less than NIMS rates.
- b) To give 10% free treatment including in-patient treatment for white cardholders.
- c) To adopt two Primary Health Centres in rural areas for delivery of quality and better health services to rural people

7. In the representation sixth read above, the Medical Superintendent, Yasodha Hospital, Somajiguda Hyderabad has accepted to give 10% free treatment to white Card holders, to charge 10% less than NIMS rates and to adopt two Primary Health Centres in Rural areas to give better services.

8. Government after careful consideration of the matter and in terms of Rule 7 of Andhra Pradesh Integrated Medical Attendance Rules, 1972, hereby accord recognition to the Yashoda Super Speciality Hospital, Somajiguda, Hyderabad as a referral Hospital for the specialised treatments to the State Government employees, their dependents and retired State Government employees and their dependents on reimbursement basis and also for those specialised treatments which are not available in Government Teaching Hospitals/NIMS/SVIMS, subject to the following conditions.

- (i) The abovementioned Private Hospital will be referral hospital for emergency cases of Acute Myocardial Infarction; Acute Coronary Disease; Acute Renal Failure; Severe cases of Head and spinal injury and cases of Coma;
- (ii) Referral of patients to the above private hospital should be from the Director, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad, Director, Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupathi and other Government Teaching hospitals in the State ;
- (iii) The NIMS/SVIMS, Government Teaching Hospitals shall ensure that facilities available in their hospitals are fully utilised in the first instance., before referring the patients to the above private hospital.
- (iv) The aforesaid Hospital should charge 10% less than the NIMS rates from the State Government employees and their dependents, retired State Government employees and their dependents. The hospital while issuing bills, a certificate should be issued to concerned employee /retired employee to the effect that the charges collected are 10% less than the existing NIMS rates for the said treatment.
- (v) The aforesaid hospital should give free medical treatment for Clinical Services, Diagnostic services and also Inpatient services for white card holders of the State of Andhra Pradesh to a minimum of 10% of the patients treated in the hospital in a financial year. They should not collect any fees /charges from the white card holders for the treatment and services rendered to them. This should be properly documented in a Register by the said hospital and the said Register is subject to periodic verification by the officer of O/o Director Medical Education, A.P., Hyderabad. The cases referred by District Collectors/ District Referral Committees shall be admitted for free treatment accordingly;
- (vi) The Hospital should adopt two Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in rural areas for delivery of better health services to rural people. The Director of Medical Education will identify the

two Primary Health Centres for this purpose;

- (vii) A 20% cut shall be imposed on the gross admissible amount within the ceiling limit as certified by the Director of Medical Education A.P., Hyderabad on the cases where the patient admitted in the above Private hospital under emergency condition without referral letter from NIMS /SVIMS/ any Government Teaching Hospital

9. The permission accorded in para (8) above is liable for cancellation whenever the State Government forms the opinion that the said Private Hospital is not providing treatment to the State Government employees/retired employees and their dependents as stipulated above and violates the above conditions mentioned therein, after giving (15) days notice to the Hospital and pass appropriate orders, after considering the representation, if any, offered against the said notice.

10. The Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad, shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
