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ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, orders have been issued recognising certain private hospitals within and outside the State as referral hospitals for the treatment of the Government employees, Retired employees and their dependents on reimbursement basis. Subsequently, some more hospitals have also been included in the list of recognised hospitals as referral hospitals within the State.

2. In the representation third read above, the Managing Director, Sai Vani Hospital, Domalguda, Hyderabad has stated that their hospital is having 100 beds and located opposite to Indira Park on Ramakrishna Math Road and easily accessible through the buses etc. and supported by well trained front line staff and having medicare facilities.

3. The Managing Director, Sai Vani Hospital, Domalguda, Hyderabad has requested the Government to accord permission to Sai Vani Hospital, Domalguda, Hyderabad as a referral Hospital for A.P. State Government Employees /Retired employees and their dependents on reimbursement basis.

4. The matter has been referred to the Director of Medical Education for report. In the letter dated 8.4.2002, the Director of Medical Education has submitted the report in the matter. While forwarding the inspection report of the Superintendent, Gandhi Hospital, Secunderabad in respect of the said Hospital, the Director of Medical Education has recommended that the hospital may be recognised as referral hospital for the treatment of State Government Employees both in-service and retired and their dependents for reimbursement purpose. As per the Inspection Report, the following specialities/facilities are available in Sai Vani Hospital, Domalguda, Hyderabad :-

- 1) Casualty, (2) out patient block, (3) Acute Medical Care (AMC) (4) ICU (5) Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) (6) Neuro Surgery (7) Burns ward and Plastic Surgery (8) Gynecology (9) Gastroentriology (10) Cardiology Department (11) Urology and Nephrology. The Hospital is equipped to treat patients for various specialties like ENT Ophthalmology, Oncology and Dental facilities (12) Operations Theatres are fully equipped to tackle any surgical emergencies of General surgery, neuro surgery, orthopedics urology Gynecology etc. etc.,

5. The following are diagnostic facilities available in the hospital:-

“C.T. Scan, Cardiac Color Doppler, Computerised stress test
NASAN from Genesis Electro Encephalography ECG, Ultra
Sound 300 MA-X/Ray, Round the clock laboratory service “.

6. In the letter fifth read above, the Managing Director, Sai Vani Hospital, Domalguda, Hyderabad has been informed that Government proposed the following conditions for according recognition of their hospital:-

- (i) The Hospital concerned should charge 10% less than the NIMS rates or as may be prescribed by the Committee constituted in G.O.Rt.No.90, HM&FW (G1) Dept, dt.29-01-2003 or Hospital Development Societies constituted in G.O.Ms.No.90, HM&FW (M1) Dept, dt.17-4-2003.
- (ii) The Hospital should give free treatment for outpatient and in-patient services including diagnostic and clinical services to the white card holders of the State of Andhra Pradesh or persons below poverty line to a minimum of 5% of bed strength or 5% of the patients treated in the hospital in the previous year.
- (iii) The Hospital should adopt two Primary Health Centers (PHCs) in rural areas for delivery of better health services to rural people.
- (iv) The Hospitals should give free medical treatment to students of Andhra Pradesh Social Welfare Residential School,
- v) The Hospital shall furnish a half yearly return in Annexure-I to the Director of Medical Education, A.P. Hyderabad.
- vi) Failure to comply with any of the above conditions entail cancellation, without any notice, of recognition, if any,

7. In the representation sixth read above, the Managing Director, Sai Vani Hospital, Domalguda, Hyderabad has accepted all the conditions mentioned above.

8. Government after careful consideration of the matter and in terms of Rule 7 of Andhra Pradesh Integrated Medical Attendance Rules, 1972, hereby accord recognition to the Managing Director, Sai Vani Hospital, (A unit of Lakshmi Jaya Hospitals Limited), 1-2-365/36/6&7 Ramakrishna Math Road, Opp. Indira Park, Domalguda, Hyderabad-29 as a referral Hospital for the specialised treatments to the State Government employees, their dependents and retired State Government employees and their dependents on reimbursement basis and also for those specialized treatments which are not available in Government Teaching Hospitals /NIMS, Hyderabad/SVIMS, Tirupati, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) Referral of patients to the above private hospital should be from the Director, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad, Director, Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medial Sciences, Tirupati and other Government Teaching hospitals in the State;
- (ii) The NIMS/SVIMS and Government Teaching Hospitals shall ensure that facilities available in their hospitals are fully utilised in the first instance, before referring the patients to the above private hospital.
- (iii) The Hospital concerned should charge 10% less than the NIMS rates or as may be prescribed by the Committee constituted in G.O.Rt.No. 90, HM&FW(G1)Dept, dt.29-01-2003 or Hospital Development Societies constituted in G.O.Ms.No.90, HM&FW (M1) Dept, dated 17-4-2003 from the Government employees and their dependents, retired State. Government employees and their dependents in case where specialty is not available in NIMS, Hyderabad. The Hospital should issue a certificate to the concerned employee/ retired employee to the effect that the charges collected are 10% less than the existing NIMS rates for the said treatment or as per rates prescribed by Committee referred to above.
- iv) The Hospital should give free treatment for outpatient and in-patient services including diagnostic and clinical services to the white card holders of the State of Andhra Pradesh or persons below poverty line to a minimum of 5 % of bed strength or 5% of the patients treated in the hospital in the previous year. This should be properly documented in a Register by the said hospital and the said Register will be subject to verification by the officer of O/o Director of Medical Education, A.P. Hyderabad periodically. The below poverty line patients will be referred by the District Referral Committee headed by the District Collector concerned or Superintendents of Government Hospitals or by Government in Health Medical and Family Welfare Department.
- v) The Hospitals should give free medical treatment to students of Andhra Pradesh Social Welfare Residential Schools Tribal Welfare Residential Schools and B.C.Welfare residential schools whenever referred by the Principal of the Residential School, Government Medical Officer, District Referral Committee, District

Social Welfare Officer or Project Officer, Integrated Tribal Development Agency or any authorised official to be notified by Government from time to time

- vi) The Hospital should adopt two Primary Health Centers (PHCs) in rural areas for delivery of better health services to rural people. The Director of Medical Education will identify the two PHCs., for this purpose in consultation with hospital concerned.
- vii) The Hospital shall furnish a half yearly return in Annexure-I enclosed to this G.O. to the Director of Medical Education, A.P. Hyderabad.
- viii) A 20% cut shall be imposed on the gross admissible amount within the ceiling limit as certified by the Director of Medical Education A.P., Hyderabad on the cases where the patient admitted in the above Private hospital under emergency condition without referral letter from NIMS /SVIMS/ any Government Teaching Hospitals.
- ix) The recognition accorded will be valid for a period of these years only and they should seek renewal three months before expiry of the said period.

9. The permission accorded in para (8) above is liable for cancellation and such other action as deemed fit, whenever the State Government forms the opinion that the said Private Hospital is not providing treatment to the State Government employees/retired employees and their dependents as stipulated above and violates the above conditions mentioned therein, after giving (15) days notice to the Hospital and pass appropriate orders, after considering the representation, if any, offered by the said Hospital .

10. Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad, shall take necessary further action in the matter accordingly
