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ORDER : -

In the G.O. first read above, orders have been issued recognizing certain private hospitals within and outside the State as referral hospitals for the treatment of the Government employees, retired employees and their dependents on reimbursement basis. Subsequently, some more hospitals have also been included in the list of recognized hospitals as referral hospitals within the State.

2. In the reference third read above, the Superintendent, Rohini Medicare (Pvt.) Limited, Hanamkonda has stated that their hospital is a 250 bedded multi-specialty institution with primary, secondary and tertiary care referral facilities. The hospital is having experienced consultants in all the basic specialities and super specialities as well. Their hospital is catering to the needs of the patients from Warangal, Karimnagar, Khammam, Nalgonda and Adilabad Districts since last 11 years.

3. The Superintendent, Rohini Hospital has requested the Government to accord permission to Rohini Hospital as a referral hospital for AP State Government Employees.

4. The matter has been referred to the Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad for report. The Director of Medical Education, has in turn referred to the Superintendent, MGM Hospital, Warangal for report. In the Inspection Committee Report dated 3-10-2000, the Inspection Committee has reported that the hospital is having all kinds of facilities and adequate staff and eligible for recognition as referral hospital for the treatment of State government employees both in service, retired and their dependents for reimbursement purpose.

5. In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Medical Education has forwarded the above Inspection Report and requested the Government to issue necessary orders at an early date.

6. In the letter fifth read above, the Superintendent, Rohini Medicare (Pvt) Limited, Hanamakonda, Warangal has been informed that Government proposed the following conditions for according recognition of their hospital.

- i) The hospital concerned should charge 10% less than the NIMS rates or as may be prescribed by

the committee constituted in G.O.Rt.No.90, HM&FW (G1) Department, dated 29-1-03 or Hospital Development Societies constituted in G.O.Ms.No.90, HM&FW (M1) Dept, dt 17-4-03.

- ii) The hospital should give free treatment for outpatient and in-patient services including diagnostic and clinical services to the white card holders of the State of AP or persons below poverty line to a minimum of 5% of bed strength or 5% of the patients treated in the hospital in the previous year.
- iii) The hospital should adopt two Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in rural areas for delivery of better health services to rural people.
- iv) The Hospitals should give free medical treatment to students of Andhra Pradesh Social Welfare Residential School
- v) The Hospital shall furnish a half yearly return in Annexure-I to the Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad.
- vi) Failure to comply with any of the above conditions, entail cancellation, without any notice of recognition, if any

7. In the representation sixth read above, the Superintendent, Rohini Medicate (Pvt) Limited, Hanamakonda, Warangal has accepted all the conditions mentioned above and requested the Government to take necessary action.

8. Government after careful consideration of the matter and in terms of Rule 7 of Andhra Pradesh Integrated Medical Attendance Rules, 1972, hereby accord recognition to the Superintendent, Rohini Medicare (Pvt.) Limited, Hanamkonda - 506 001, Warangal District as a referral hospital for the specialized treatments to the State Government employees, their dependents and retired State Government employees and their dependents on reimbursement basis and also for those specialized treatments which are not available in Government Teaching Hospitals, NIMS, Hyderabad, SVIMS, Tirupati, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) referral of patients to the above private hospital should be from the Director, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad, Director, Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati and other Government Teaching hospitals in the State;
- (ii) The NIMS, SVIMS and Government Teaching Hospitals shall ensure that facilities available in their hospitals are fully utilized in the first instance, before referring the patients to the above private hospitals;
- (iii) The hospital concerned should charge 10% less than the NIMS rates or as may be prescribed by the Committee constituted in G.O.Rt.No.90, HM&FW (G1) Dept., dt 29-01-03 or Hospital Development Societies constituted in G.O.Ms.No.90, HM&FW (M1) Dept., dt 17-4-03 from the Government employees and their dependents, retired State Government employees and their dependents in case where speciality is not available in NIMS, Hyderabad. The hospital should issue a certificate to the concerned employee / retired employee to the effect that the charges collected are 10% less than the existing NIMS rates for the said treatment or as per rates prescribed by Committee referred to above;
- (iv) The hospital should give free treatment for outpatient and in-patient services including diagnostic and clinical services to the white card holders of the State of Andhra Pradesh or persons below poverty line to a minimum of 5% of bed strength of 5% of the patients treated in the hospital in the previous year. This should be properly documented in a register by the said hospital and the aid register will be subject to verification by the officer of O/o Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad periodically. The below poverty line patients will be referred by the District Referral Committee headed by the District Collector concerned or Superintendents of Government Hospitals or by concerned or Superintendents of Government Hospitals or PO, ITDA or by Government in Health Medical and Family Welfare Department.

- (v) The Hospital should give free medical treatment to students of Andhra Pradesh Social Welfare Residential Schools, Tribal Welfare Residential Schools / BC Welfare Residential Schools whenever referred by the Principal of the Residential School, Government Medical Officer, District Referral Committee, District Social Welfare Officer or PO, ITDA or any authorized officials to be notified by Government from time to time.
- (vi) The hospital should adopt two Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in rural areas for delivery of better health services to rural people. The Director of Medical Education will identify the two PHCs for this purpose in consultation with hospital concerned.
- (vii) The hospital shall furnish a half yearly return in Annexure-I enclosed to this G.O. to the Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad.
- (viii) A 20% cut shall be imposed on the gross admissible amount within the ceiling limit as certified by the Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad on the cases where the patient admitted in the above private hospital under emergency condition without referral letter from NIMS/SVIMS/ any Government Teaching Hospitals.
- (ix) The recognition accorded will be valid for a period of three years only and they should seek renewal three months before expiry of the said period.

9. The permission accorded in para (8) above is liable for cancellation and such other action as deemed fit, whenever the State Government forms the opinion that the said private hospital is not providing treatment to the State Government employees/ retired employees and their dependents as stipulated above and violates the above conditions mentioned therein, after giving (15) days notice to the hospital and pass appropriate orders, after considering the representation, if any, offered by the said Hospital.

10. The Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad shall take necessary further action in the matter accordingly.
