ORDER:

In the reference first read above, Sri Ramelli Adellu S/o Late Ramulu has filed Revision Petition through his Counsel before the Government against the order dated 28.8.2000 in Case No.D4/Ag/5//2000 of the Agent to Government, Adilabad . After examination of the case records and material papers notices have been sent to the concerned to attend the hearing of the Revision Petition on 16.12.2002. After few adjournments the Revision Petition finally came up for hearing on 5.5.2003. The Counsel for the petitioner has appeared and presented his arguments in line with the averments put forth in the revision petition. He contended that the petitioner never sold the property to the 4th Respondent herein i.e., to Sri Kuncherla Gambheer. He finally argued that the revenue officials have colluded with the 4th respondent and illegally carried out mutations in the records in favour of the 4th respondent,. Therefore the Counsel for the petitioner has requested to set aside the orders of the lower courts in the interest of justice..

2. On examination of the records and material papers made available, it is found that the lower court held that during the course of hearing the petitioner and the respondent (both non -tribals) have admitted that the land is with the 4th respondent i.e., Sri Kuncherla Gambheer since 1991 and the petitioner has taken loan from the 4th respondent, and as such the sale transaction took place in between two non-tribals violating the provisions of the A.P .Scheduled Areas Land transfer Regulation, 1959, read with amended Regulation 1 of 1970.

3. In view of the above position Government see no reason to interfere with the order dated 28.8.2000 in Case D4/Ag/5/2000 of the Agent to Government, Adilabad in confirming the order of the lower court. In the result the order of the Agent to Government, Adilabad is upheld and the R.P. filed by Sri Ramelli Abdellu is dismissed.The Counsel for the revision petitioner is requested to inform his client accordingly

4. The Collector, Adilabad is requested to take necessary further action in the matter.
