ORDER:

In the reference first read above Smt.Dasari Laxmi has filed Revision Petition through her Counsel, before the Government, against the order of the Agent to Government, Khammam in CMA No. 7/1997 ,dated 10.10.1997 in respect of land of Acs.1.32 gts in S.No12-A situated in Kakarla village, Julurpad Mandal, Khammam district.. After examination of the case records and material papers notices have been sent to the concerned to attend the hearing on 26.8.2002, but they failed to attend the said hearing. Subsequently, they have been provided with opportunity of being heard on 30.12.2002, 10.2.2003, 10.3.2003, 10.4.2003, 2.6.2003, 21.7.2003 and 18.8.2003, but they failed to utilize the opportunities to adduce the grievances.

2. On examination of the records and orders, the contention of the revision petitioner is that she is in possession of the petition scheduled land since 1968 i e much prior to coming into force of Andhra Pradesh Scheduled Areas Land Transfer Regulation, 1959, as amended in 1970 . The Special Deputy Collector (TW), Palvancha held that the petitioner has not filed pahani extracts and land revenue receipts in support of her claim except the sada sale deed dt.6.8.1968 executed by the vendor which is neither valid nor acceptable. The Court of Agent to Government, Khammam, held that the land revenue receipts book containing scribed receipts from 1968-69 to 1979-80 produced in his Court is unauthorised one, as it is not containing official seal of the Tahsildar, Kothagudem, and as such the documents produced by the petitioner are fabricated by after thought. The petitioner has failed to prove lawful possession over the petition scheduled land prior to coming into force of the Regulation 1/70..

3. In view of the above position, the Government see no reason to interfere with the orders of the Lower Courts. In the result the order dated 10.10.1997 in CMA No.7/1997 of the Agent to Government, Khammam in confirming the order of the Special Deputy Collector (TW), Palvancha is upheld and the R.P filed by Smt. Dasari Laxmi is dismissed. The Counsel for the Revision petitioner is requested to inform his client accordingly.

4.The Collector, Khammam is requested to take necessary further action in the matter.
