**RELIEF & REHABILITATION PACKAGE AS PER THE NATIONAL POLICY**

- 1 Allotment of agricultural land or cultivable :  
wasteland to the extent of actual land loss  
subject to a maximum of one hectare of  
irrigated land or two hectares of un-  
irrigated land / cultivable wasteland

subject to availability of Government land in the district

- 2 Allotment of house sites free of cost to those Project Affected Families (PAF) whose houses have been acquired :
- 3 One time grant of Rs. 25,000/- for house construction of families Below Poverty Line (BPL) :
- 4 One time financial grant of Rs. 10,000/- per hectare for land development and Rs. 5,000/- per PAF for agricultural production :
- 5 Financial assistance of Rs. 3,000/- for construction of cattle sheds and Rs. 5,000/- for transportation cost to each PAF :
- 6 Each displaced PAF to get a monthly allowance @ 20 days Minimum Agricultural Wages (MAW) for a period of one year upto 250 days of MAW :
- 7 EACH PAF whose entire land has been acquired shall get one time financial assistance equivalent to 750 days of MAW for "loss of livelihood" :
- 8 Each PAF whose entire land has not been acquired and consequently becomes a marginal or small farmer will get one time financial assistance equivalent to 500 days of MAW and 375 days of MAW respectively :
- 9 Agricultural labour or non-agricultural labour to get financial assistance equivalent to 625 days of MAW :
- 10 Each PAF of rural artisans, small traders and self-employed people will get financial assistance of Rs. 10,000/- for construction of shops or working sheds :
- 11 A one time financial assistance equivalent to 500 days of MAW for loss of customary / grazing . fishing rights in addition to other R&R benefits to tribal PAFs. :
- 12 Tribal families resettled out of the district to get higher R&R benefits to the extent of 25% in monetary terms :
- 13 Foolproof Review Mechanism consisting of representatives of affected families, including SC/ST, women elected :

representatives and Government machinery

- 14 Tribal PAFs will be resettled close to their natural habitat in a compact block so that they can retain their ethnic, linguistic and cultural identity :
- 15 The Tribal Land Alienated in violation of the laws and regulations in force on the subject would be treated as null and void and the R&R benefits would be available only to the original tribal :
- 16 The tribal families residing in the Project Affected Areas having fishing rights in the river / pond / dam shall be given fishing rights in the reservoir area :
- 17 Tribal PAFs enjoying reservation benefits in the affected zone shall be entitled to get the reservation benefits at the resettlement zone :
