Sri Tumu Subbarayudu and Tumu Maredeswara Rao R/o Dusaripamu (V) Rajavommangi (M), East Godavari District, have filed an appeal petition 2nd cited, under section 7(2) of Act 16 of 1993, before the Govt. against the proceedings of the Collector, East Godavari District dated 31.8.2000, without affixing signature.

On perusal of the appeal petition filed by individuals, it is understood that they have filed W.P. No. 18595/2000 before APHC., Hyderabad, praying to set-aside the proceedings of the Collector, East Godavari District dated 31.8.2000 cancelling their caste certificates. The APHC., Hyderabad in its orders dated 13.7.2001 directed the petitioners to file statutory appeal within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order and on such filing of appeal by the petitioner, the Govt. shall consider and dispose of the same on merits. Accordingly they filed the common appeal petition 2nd cited. The appeal petition submitted by the appellants is found to be without their signatures. It is also found that they have not filed any valid documentary evidence in support of their claim as ST such as genealogical tree information, Birth and Death Extracts of the Ancestors and School records etc.

Further, while the APHC. in their order dated 13.7.2001 has directed the petitioners to file appeal petition before the Govt. within a period of 4 weeks, the petitioner have submitted their appeal petitions, after the lapse of the period of four years, that too without affixing their signature and praying for condonation of the delay.

Government after careful examination of all the above aspects of the case does not consider it necessary to revise the orders passed by the Collector, East Godavari District in the reference 1st cited. Therefore, Govt. in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 7(2) of A.P.(SC, STS & BCs) Regulation of issue of community certificates Act 16/93 and rules made there under, hereby reject the appeal petition filed by the appellants. as there are no merits in the case, and the proceedings issued by the Collector, East Godavari District in the reference 1st cited are here by upheld.
