

## IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF R&R POLICY (GOMs 68 I&CAD) DEPT, DT 8-4-05

1. Projects affecting even 25 or more tribal families en-mass
2. Project Administrator to hold consultations with Project Affected Families while preparing for R&R Plan
3. Wherever tribal families are involved CTW shall be involved by Commissioner, R&R
4. Contents of R&R plan shall be published in the Village/Locality
5. R&R benefits
  - Free house site-15 Sq Ft
  - House construction - Rs. 40000/-
  - Land Development in case of waste or degraded land - Rs. 10000/-
  - Agriculture Production in case of agriculture land - Rs. 5000/-
  - Allotment of land - 2.5 Ha Dry or 1.25 Ha of wet land
  - Grant for cattle shed - Rs. 3000/-
  - Grant for transporting materials - Rs. 5000/-
  - Income generating scheme for rural artisans - Rs. 25000/-
  - Wages 240 to 750 days depending on the loss due to project
6. Reservation benefits in the affected zone shall be entitled to get the same reservation benefits
7. Basic benefits to be provided at Resettlement Centre which were available in the original village
8. R&R BENEFITS PROJECTS AFFECTED FAMILIES OF SCHEDULED TRIBES
  - (a) Each Project Affected Family of ST category shall be given preference in allotment of land
  - (b) Each tribal PAF shall get additional financial assistance equivalent to 500 days minimum agriculture wages for loss of customary rights / usages of forest produce
  - (c) Tribal PAFs will be re-settled close to their natural habitat of their choice, to the extent possible, in a compact block so that they can retain their ethnic, linguistic and

cultural identify.

- (d) Tribal PAFs resettled out of the district or outside tribal area will get 25% higher R&R benefits in monetary terms
- (e) The Tribal Land Alienated in violation of the laws and regulations in force on the subject would be treated as null and void and the R&R benefits would be available only to the original tribal landowner.
- (f) The Tribal families residing in the Project Affected Areas having fishing rights in the river/pond/dam shall be given fishing rights in the reservoir area.
