

## 1. INCORPORATION

- Established under Companies Act 1956 during the year 2001
- Joint Venture Company (JVC) of AP TRICOR (74%) and APMDC (26%).
- Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the AP TRICOR and the APMDC executed on 30-11-2000.

## 2. CAPITAL BASE

- Authorized share capital : Rs.1.00 crore divided into 10.00 lakh shares of Rs.10 each Paid up capital Rs.11.00 lakhs.

## 3. OBJECTIVES

To harness the mining potential in tribal areas for improving the living conditions of Tribal communities by distributing the mineral wealth generated, by exploitation of various mineral resources lying in the tribal regions of the state.

## 4. FUNCTIONS & ACTIVITIES

- To acquire prospecting licenses, mining leases & quarry leases for semi precious stones and other minerals in forest areas and scheduled areas in the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- To organize the tribals in formation of Tribal Cooperative Societies (TCS) under A.P. Cooperative Societies Act, 1964 or any other Act in force for the purpose of taking up of mining activities.
- To facilitate, guide & assist the Tribal Co-operative Societies in setting up infrastructure facilities for prospecting, raising, processing, screening & washing and treating the material bearing mineral at suitable places.
- To provide necessary technical guidance, equipments & manpower to the society for their activities.
- To set up common facilities and processing plants for separation, recovery and up-gradation of the mineral.
- To provide necessary assistance for and to undertake evaluation and marketing of the minerals.

- In addition to the activities described as objectives, the JVC shall strive for acquiring PLs / MLs / OLs for Semi-precious stones and other minerals in forest areas and scheduled areas in the state of Andhra Pradesh by the TCSs.
- Allot the Mineral bearing areas to the respective TCS for carrying on prospecting and mining operations.
- Procure the machinery required and make available to the societies on job work basis.
- Establish centrally located processing plants wherever required for processing / concentrating of minerals.

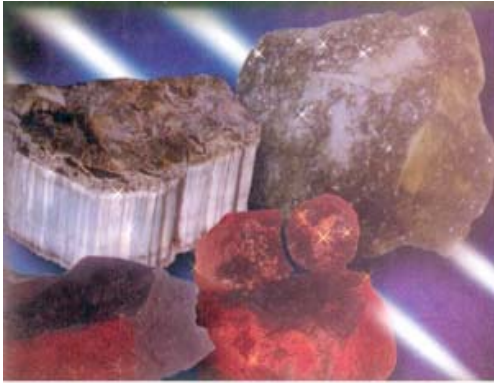
