Certain instructions were issued vide references 10th and 11th cited on capturing accurate data of coordinates and recording. In continuation of the above, the following instructions are issued for recording claim wise coordinates during the survey for generation of maps and title deeds through software package.

- In certain ITDAs, for each land parcel, >30 coordinates are being taken. It is clarified that taking so many coordinates is not necessary. Coordinates **should be collected only for bend points of a land parcel** so that they can be fully entered on Pages of pass book, on the survey map etc.,. It is reiterated that **correct, full and same** coordinates data should be recorded on
 - i. Page 4 of pass book
 - ii. Page 5 of pass book where map is shown
 - iii. Page 7 of the passbook where second map shown
- On the parcel map of the pass book the bend point numbers should be given **in bold** so that they will be clearly visible even in the scanned copy.

The POs of ITDAs and DTWOs of non-ITDA districts are requested to follow the above instructions strictly during the survey of claims and preparation of parcel maps and generation of title deeds through system.
